

PURPOSE To provide guidance as to the appropriate role of vendors and service providers in the Association.

POLICY

Associate Membership Individuals employed by a private sector entity that provides goods or services to the public sector are invited to participate in the Association as a non-voting Associate member.

Associate members are required to comply with the Associate Members Code of Conduct.

Volunteers Associate members may be invited to serve as volunteers on IGFOA standing and ad-hoc committees. Associate members participating as committee volunteers may provide advice to the committee but shall have no rights to vote or contribute to consensus decisions of the committee.

Associate members are not eligible to serve as Committee Chairs or Chapter officers.

Associate members are not eligible to serve as coordinators or hosts of IGFOA state-wide or chapter sponsored social events so as to avoid the appearance that the event is hosted or solely sponsored by the Associate member.
