Scott Brandt joined the former Department of Insurance in 1985 after graduating with a degree in Actuarial Science from the University of Illinois in Urbana-Champaign. Since joining the Public Pension Division, Scott's responsibilities have increased, culminating with his appointment as Acting Chief Administrator since July 17, 2004

As Acting Chief Administrator of the Illinois Department of Financing and Professional Regulation's Public Pension Division, he is in charge of the ten staff member division, responsible for the monitoring and compliance of all public pension funds in the State of Illinois. As of March 31, 2005, there are 277 down state and suburban fire funds, 343 police funds and 15 large statewide, Chicago and Cook County Retirement Systems.
