













Sales Tax Production by District,


(2004 - 2013)



- For the ingredients of fiscal impact analysis, to what degree can they be standardized across cities?
- Where is flexibility needed for local conditions?



Key Ingredients to FIA

- Community goals
- Realistic assumptions about impact

Stakeholder involvement

Shared terminology

Parameters for acceptable development



For the key ingredients, where do you think a national standard from GFOA and APA would be most helpful to you?

1 minute silent contemplation

2 minutes to talk to a partner

4 minutes for 2 pairs to discuss



- Write your favorite idea on an index card
- Mill around the room passing & receiving cards
 - Goal is to randomly distribute cards
- When chime rings stop and...
